Temple Community Clinic provides care to adult patients ages 18-65 in need that do not qualify for government health programs.

Patients of Temple Community Clinic are 18 - 65 years old, do not qualify for health programs like Medicaid, Medicare, or indigent care, must be residents of Bell County, and are uninsured or under insured. They must have some form of household income.

To be eligible you will need to provide documentation for the following:

- Ages between 18 -64
- Be a resident of Bell County
- Verifiable proof of household income (Last 2 paycheck stubs, Social Security award letter or wage verification form)
- Proof of benefits received from SNAP (formerly known as food stamps), Public Assistance, TANF,
 SSI, Child Support, CHIPS, Medicaid
- Texas Photo ID & Social Security Card
- Proof of Bell County residency (any utility bill or lease agreement)
- Tax Return if you filed in the last year

Those who do NOT qualify:

- Those who have Medicaid, Medicare, VA Services, TRICARE or County Indigent Programs
- Those who suffer from work related injuries involving Workman's Compensation

Once eligibility is established, patients can make appointments for chronic or acute care, prescription assistance, and specialty clinics such as:

- Cardiology
- Dental
- Dermatology
- Gastroenterology
- Gynecology
- Mental Health
- Optometry
- Podiatry
